| 1 | <b>Can I change my electives later? What if I don't know what I want to take?</b>   | No-there are no elective changes allowed after May 21st. You must choose your electives and alternates carefully the first time. If you don't list alternates, your counselor will select them for you. | 2 | <b>What if I want to take an AP class but my teacher didn't recommend me?</b>       | You can still try to take the class by submitting a waiver request form online between <b>March 23-27</b> . <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You must meet the S2 9-week grade requirement listed in the course catalog.</li><li>• You can only submit two waiver requests total.</li><li>• Submitting more than two means none will be processed.</li><li>• Placement also depends on seat availability. Completing a waiver request does <b>NOT</b> guarantee placement in course.</li></ul>  |
| 3 | <b>Can I take more than one online class next year?</b>                             | Students are allowed only one online course during the school day (only IF they complete the online course request form and turn it in by May 11 <sup>th</sup> ).
