

# Class of 2024 and 2025 – Freshman and Sophomore Parent Night FAQ

## **Which classes give you college credit?**

Our AP courses provide college credit; however, this will depend on the college, the AP course, and the AP Exam score. Dual Enrollment classes will provide college credit.

## **What is the national merit scholarship?**

The National Merit scholarship is the scholarship based on the PSAT during the Junior year. The score is based on a national percentage and will differ each year.

## **Will sophomores need to take the GA Milestones?**

The 4 courses that require GA Milestones will be Algebra I, Geometry, US History, and 11<sup>th</sup> American Literature.

## **Are SAT or ACT scores posted on the transcript?**

No, the SAT or ACT scores will not be posted on the transcript.

## **Can a parent schedule a meeting with the counselor?**

Parents are welcome to email their counselors to schedule individual meetings.

## **Is honor roll based on weighted or unweighted numeric average?**

The honor roll is based on the weighted numeric average.
