



**Cisco High School STEM Externship  
Summer 2020 Program Details**

The Cisco High School STEM Program is a comprehensive 2 to 4-week unpaid summer externship designed to give top, STEM and business focused students an introduction to Cisco’s history, culture, and the technology industry.

Students will be engaged in interactive project work, problem-solving, and learn to communicate with industry professionals and peers.

**Students will...**

- Shadow Cisco employees in the student’s field of interest
- Work in teams under the guidance of professional mentors to creatively solve a business problem.
- Participate in a day-long Innovation Challenge (Hackathon-style).
- Participate in team-building and development activities.
- Compete in a final project related to Internet of Things (IoT).
- Receive school credit, where possible.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Current junior or senior (Graduating in 2020 or 2021)
- Minimum 3.5 GPA, either weighted or unweighted
- Demonstrable interest in Business and/or Technology
